

Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

Work to commence on cyclist and pedestrian improvements in Drummoyne

From Monday 29 March, work will begin on cyclist and pedestrian improvements in Drummoyne. The work will take about eight weeks to complete and will involve:

- Installation of new signs and pavement marking.
- A new on-road route along Wrights Road between Wolseley Street and Lyons Road, including changes to the intersection of Wrights Road and Seymour Street and to the land on the corner of Wrights Road and Lyons Road.
- Improvements to the existing on-road route along Renwick Street between Lyons Road and Day Street.
- A new connection between Roseby Street and Cary Street.

Approximately eight parking spaces will be removed at the intersection of Wrights Road and Seymour Street to provide a continued connection to the bicycle route. Signs and pavement markings will be installed to guide cyclists.

These improvements follow consideration of over forty submissions in response to the environmental assessment, which was publicly exhibited in December 2009, and forms part of the program of works for the Drummoyne area.

Work hours

Work will be done during the day with some night work required to maintain traffic flows on Victoria Road. Noisy work will, wherever possible, be done during the day to minimise noise impact on the local community. Other work, which has less its impact, may be done from midnight to 5am.
