

## **Inner West Busway** along Victoria Road

### **Work to commence on cyclist and pedestrian improvements at Henley Marine Drive, Drummoyne**

#### **24 March, 2010**

From Monday, 29 March work will begin on cyclist and pedestrian improvements in Drummoyne. Work will involve the realignment of Henley Marine Drive near Formosa Street to construct a shared-use cyclist and pedestrian ramp.

The ramp will connect Henley Marine Drive to the new bridge over Iron Cove. The ramp will provide an improved connection between the Bay Run and a new 4.3m shared-use cyclist and pedestrian path to be built on the new bridge over Iron Cove. The path on the existing bridge will be retained.

Work to realign Henley Marine Drive will take about three months to complete and will involve:

- Realigning the kerb and pavement from Formosa Street to the Iron Cove Bridge on Henley Marine Drive.
- Installing concrete barriers between the road and the ramp for driver safety.
- Placing pavement under the ramp for visual amenity
- Resurfacing the newly aligned section of Henley Marine Drive.

The right turn storage lane on Henley Marine Drive will be permanently removed. However, traffic will still be permitted to turn right from Henley Marine Drive into Formosa Street.

Construction of the ramp will commence in the second half of 2010 and will require various footpath closures. Cyclist and pedestrians will be detoured around the site. Henley Marine Drive will remain open to traffic and access to nearby businesses, including The Cove Café will be maintained.

#### **Work hours**

Work will be done mainly in the day with some night work required. Noisy work will, wherever possible, be done during the day to minimise its impact on the local community. Other work, which has less noise impact, may be done from midnight to 5am.
