

## Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

13 April 2010

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION – Work to begin on bus bay at Cary Street, Drummoyne

Work will start at Cary Street, Drummoyne on a new citybound bus bay and a cyclist path that will run behind the bus bay and connect Victoria Road with Roseby Street.

The work will begin on 18 April 2010 and will take approximately two months to complete.

The bus bay will be opened in conjunction with the Inner West Busway in 2011. Information on how this new bus bay will operate will be provided prior to the opening.

#### Access during the work

- Access will be maintained for cyclists and pedestrians at all times.
- Motorists will still be able to turn left from Victoria Road (citybound) to Cary Street or from Cary Street to Victoria Road (citybound).

The kerbside lane on Victoria Road from Park Avenue to Iron Cove Bridge will be closed between 10am and 3pm and between 7pm and 5am as needed for construction of the bus bay.

#### Type of work

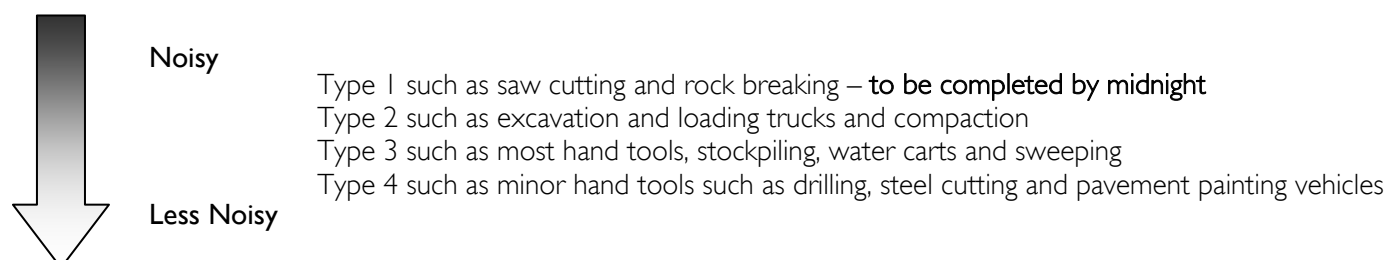
Work will involve service investigations, earthworks, excavation and the construction of the new shared-use path. Vacuum trucks, excavators with hammers, concrete trucks, rollers, vibrating plates and floodlights will be used during the night. There will be some noisy work.

#### Work hours

Work will be undertaken on weekdays between 7am and 5pm and on Saturdays between 8am and 4pm where possible. Work requiring lane closures and more extensive traffic disruption will be done during the night between 7pm and 5am (Sunday-Thursday).

#### Important information about noise during construction for residents

The impact of noise will vary depending on your proximity to the noise source, protection provided by other structures and the type of building you reside in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan, ranging on a scale of one to four. High level noise work, such as saw cutting and concrete breaking will, wherever possible, be done during the day between 10am and 3pm to minimise noise impact on the local community. Other work, which has less noise impact (generally considered as low noise work) will be done at night from 7pm to 5am to minimise their impact on traffic flow, access and parking on Victoria Road.

Intermittent periods of high noise levels between 12am and 5am will be unavoidable and may be experienced by residents in the immediate vicinity of the work.
