IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Cycleway improvements in Renwick Street, Drummoyne

From Monday 17 May 2010, the RTA will extend the existing speed humps and install new signs and pavement markings in Renwick Street, Drummoyne between Lyons Road and Day Street. Please refer to the diagram overleaf.

The work is part of the Inner West Busway Cyclist and Pedestrian Improvements project.

The work will be carried out between 7am and 5pm and involves:

- Excavation of a shallow trench and placement and compaction of hot mix asphalt to match the height and width of the existing speed humps on Monday 17 May 2010. There will be some noise created at times by this activity. Parking near the speed humps will not be available to complete this work. Approximately 10 metres on either side of each speed hump will be barricaded.
- Pavement marking to establish bicycle shoulder lanes. Parking will not be available on the eastern side of Renwick Street on Tuesday 18 May 2010 and on the western side of Renwick Street on Wednesday 19 May 2010. The parking lanes will be barricaded as required.
- Installation of cycleway route signs.

The program above is subject to weather as pavement markings will not adhere to a wet road surface.
