WEEKEND WORK FOR THE NEW BRIDGE OVER IRON COVE

Weekend work on the new bridge over Iron Cove will be carried out in the construction and compound site on Henley Marine Drive in Drummoyne on Saturday 26 September and Sunday 27 September, 2009.

To construct the abutments for the new bridge over Iron Cove, it is necessary to excavate the earth embankments that support Victoria Road. Before the excavation can be done, a structure must be built to support the road. This structure is a series of closely spaced bored concrete piles, called a contiguous pile wall.

Establishment of the Drummoyne construction and compound site

Work has begun on establishing the construction and compound site in Drummoyne on Henley Marine Drive. This compound will be used to store materials for the Drummoyne abutment work and staff amenities.

The compound will not obstruct pedestrian access from Formosa Street to the rear access road.

Working hours

To minimise the impact on both the local community and traffic flow on Victoria Road, the RTA has received approval for extended working hours this weekend.

This will enable the work to excavate and remove material and place reinforced concrete piles to be completed in the shortest amount of time possible, outside of weekday peak periods and to avoid the need to do the work at night.

Work will be undertaken on Saturday and Sunday 26 and 27 September, 2009 from 8am to 8pm.

Lane closures

The clip on lane on Iron Cove Bridge will be closed while this work is being carried out.
