

## Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

13 April 2010

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION – Night works along Victoria Road, Drummoyne

As part of the work to build the new busway, the pavement joints will be replaced along Victoria Road, between Park Avenue and Westbourne Street, Drummoyne.

Work on the outbound lanes will commence at Park Avenue from Sunday 18 April 2010. It will take approximately five to seven nights to complete (weather permitting) and approximately one to two nights to pass each property.

Work will then be done on the citybound lanes commencing at Westbourne Street. This will also take approximately five to seven nights to complete (weather permitting) and approximately two to three nights to pass each property.

The work needs to be done at night when traffic lanes can be safely closed. It will involve short periods of noisy activities including high pressure air hoses and gas torches.

Most residents will only be exposed to the noise for short periods as the work will progress quickly along the road. Noise will be closely monitored.

There will be "No Stopping" restrictions along the area where work is being carried out so as to maintain traffic flow on Victoria Road.

These 'No Stopping' restrictions will be clearly signposted and a 40 km/h speed limit will apply for driver's and worker's safety.

Access to properties will remain available by using a traffic controller.
