### Drummoyne services investigation works continue

The RTA will continue investigating the location of the underground utility services along Victoria Road and its footpaths between Westbourne Street and Iron Cove Bridge. This work will be undertaken during the day and night and involves the use of a sawcutter, small jackhammer and suction truck. Night works will involve 'type a' noisy activities (see explanation next page) up to midnight.

### No weekend work on 5 & 6 December

There will be a respite from all work in Drummoyne, Rozelle and around Iron Cove on the weekend of Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 December.

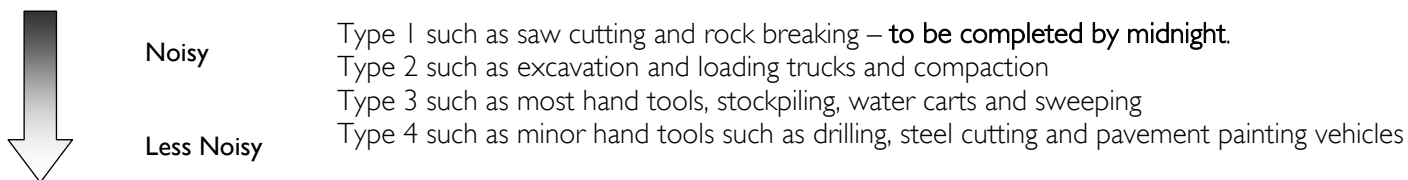

### Important information about noise during construction for residents

The impact of noise will vary depending on your proximity to the noise source, protection provided by other structures and the type of building you reside in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's *Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan*, ranging on a scale of one to four. High level noise work, such as saw cutting and concrete breaking will, wherever possible, be done during the day between 10am and 3pm to minimise noise impact on the local community. Other work, which has less noise impact (generally considered as low noise work) will be done at night from 7pm to 5am to minimise the impacts on traffic flow, access and parking on Victoria Road. Intermittent periods of high noise levels between 12am and 5am will be unavoidable and may be experienced by residents in the immediate vicinity of the work.
