

Inner West Busway along Victoria Road Construction notification – October 2009

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is continuing with construction works in Rozelle and Drummoyne in October 2009. The work includes road building and work on the new bridge over Iron Cove.

At various times, the work will create some disturbance to the surrounding community who may experience noise, vibration, dust and access impacts. Activities will be programmed to minimise these impacts wherever possible. This includes noise reduction measures, dust suppression and extensive notifications for residents.

Separate to the Inner West Busway project, the RTA will continue maintenance and repair work to the Iron Cove Bridge. For further information about this maintenance project, please contact the RTA project engineer, Kurt Bridde on (02) 9598 7743.

Changes to bus stops in Rozelle in October

Two bus stops at Evans Street and Robert Street, Rozelle (citybound) will be replaced by a bus stop between Evans Street and MacKenzie Street on Victoria Road. Work on the removal of the two bus stops is expected to commence at the end of October. Further information about the changes will be provided to bus users and residents near to these areas one week in advance of these changes occurring.

Working hours during October

The RTA will do some work in Rozelle and Drummoyne during the day, typically from 7am to 6pm, whilst the remainder needs to be done during the night typically from 7pm to 5am to minimise the impact on traffic flow, access and parking on Victoria Road.

Parking arrangements

There will be both daytime and night time restrictions on some parking along Victoria Road in Rozelle. During the times when lanes are closed 'no stopping' zones will be implemented to maintain traffic flow on Victoria Road. These zones will be clearly signposted.

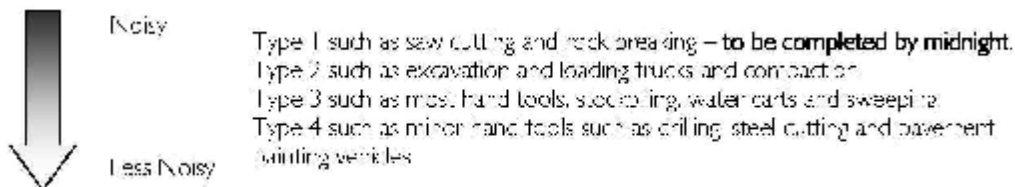
Lane closures during October

Victoria Road will remain open at all times. Traffic management signs and crews will be in place to direct drivers safely around the work areas. Drivers are requested to take care and to follow the signs.

- § Lane closures in Rozelle - temporary lane closures will continue outside of weekday peak periods.
- § Lane closures in Drummoyne - various temporary closures of the median lanes on Victoria Road (citybound and westbound) Sundays to Thursdays 10pm to 5am.

Important information about noise during construction for residents

The impact of noise will vary depending on your proximity to the noise source, protection provided by other structures and the type of building you reside in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's *Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan*, ranging on a scale of one to four. High level noise work, such as saw cutting and concrete breaking will, wherever possible, be done during the day between 10am and 3pm to minimise noise impact on the local community. Other work, which has less noise impact (generally considered as low noise work) will be done at night from 7pm to 5am to minimise the impacts on traffic flow, access and parking on Victoria Road.

Intermittent periods of high noise levels between 12am and 5am will be unavoidable and may be experienced by residents in the immediate vicinity of the work.

Rozelle road work in October – start of resurfacing and pavement marking of Victoria Road

Work is expected to commence in early October on the resurfacing and pavement marking of Victoria Road between The Crescent and Iron Cove Bridge. This work will take approximately seven weeks to complete and work crews will travel along Victoria Road, rather than being located in one site over a period of time.

This monthly schedule is based on the most up to date information at the time of printing. However, the days on which activities are undertaken and their duration are subject to change due to weather, technical issues or innovations that may arise.

Program of work during October

Rozelle

- Between Robert Street and Gordon Street
 - Gordon Street kerb work completed late October (day and night, type 1 and type 2 noise).
 - Continue pavement construction during October including joint repair work, installing the new median (day and night, type 1 and type 2 noise).
- Between Gordon Street and Evans Street
 - Continue pavement construction and repair including joint repair works, installing new median (day and night, type 1 and type 2 noise).
 - Removal of right turn into Evans Street from early October.
 - Install new median after the removal of the right turn into Evans Street from Victoria Road in early October (night, type 2 noise).
- Between Evans Street and Darling Street
 - Continue pavement construction and repair including joint repair works, installing new median and pedestrian fence (day and night, type 1 and type 2 noise).
- Between Darling Street and Wellington Street
 - Continue pavement construction and repair including joint repair works, installing the new median and pedestrian fence (day and night, type 1 and type 2 noise).
- Between Wellington Street and Terry Street
 - Continue pavement construction and repair including joint repair work, installing new median and pedestrian fence (day and night, type 1 and type 2 noise).
- Between Terry Street and Iron Cove Bridge
 - Toelle Street kerb works begin in mid October (day and night, type 1 and type 2 noise).
- King George Park construction compound including the new bridge
 - Continue construction of the Rozelle abutment for the new bridge over Iron Cove (day, type 2 noise).
 - Complete construction of pier 1 early October (day, type 1 and 2 noise)
 - Commence assembly of casting bed formwork early October (day, type 1 and 2 noise)
 - Pile cap temporary pier 1 and pier 2 mid October (day, type 1 and 2 noise)

Iron Cove and Drummoyne

- Iron Cove including the new bridge
 - Continue piling works in Iron Cove throughout October (day, type 1 and type 2 noise)
 - Pile cap pier 3 and 4 early October (day, type 1 and 2 noise)
 - Continue construction of the Drummoyne abutment for the new bridge over Iron Cove, Henley Marine Drive during October (day and night, type 2 noise).
 - Construction of pier 9 and 10 during October (day, type 1 and 2 noise),
