

Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

Construction update – November 2009

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) is continuing with construction work for the Inner West Busway on Victoria Road through Drummoyne and Rozelle.

At various times, the work will create some disturbance to the surrounding community from noise, vibration, dust and access impacts. Activities will be programmed to minimise the impact of construction wherever possible. This includes noise reduction measures, dust suppression and extensive notifications for residents.

The scope of work outlined below is based on the most up to date information at the time of printing. However, this program may change due to weather or technical issues.

Work planned for November

Rozelle road works

- Road resurfacing between The Crescent and Terry Street (early to mid November).
- Install the median pedestrian fencing between Gordon and Evans streets (throughout November).
- Install the road signage (mid November).
- Install the lane usage signage at Darling Street and Crystal Street (mid to late November).

Most of this work will be done at night and will require lane closures.

Bridgeworks in and around Iron Cove

- Continue piling in Iron Cove for the bridge piers.
- Continue construction of piers 3 and 4 throughout November (day work).
- Continue construction of the abutment for the new bridge over Iron Cove at Henley Marine Drive throughout November (day work).

Most of the work for the new bridge will be done during the day (unless there is a need to close lanes on Victoria Road).

Drummoyne bridge works

- Replace the median between Park and Cary streets (early November). Most of this work will be done at night and will require lane closures.
- Construct the bridge approaches between Terry Street, Rozelle and Park Avenue, Drummoyne (mid to late November). This will require closure of the clip-on lane over weekend periods during the day and night.

Working hours during November

The noisiest work, such as saw cutting and concrete breaking will, wherever possible, be done during the day between 10am and 3pm to minimise the impact on the local community. Other work, which is less noisy (generally considered as low noise work) will be done at night from 7pm to 5am to minimise the impact on traffic flow, access and parking on Victoria Road.

Intermittent periods of high noise levels between 12am and 5am will be unavoidable and may be experienced by residents in the immediate vicinity of the work. Where possible, we will notify these residents directly, by a letterbox notification or a door knock.

Parking arrangements

There will be both daytime and night time restrictions on some parking along Victoria Road in Rozelle and Drummoyne. During the times when lanes are closed 'no stopping' zones will be implemented to maintain traffic flow on Victoria Road. These zones will be clearly signposted.
