Working hours are typically Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Sunday to Thursday 7pm to 5am with high noise activities to be undertaken during the day or before midnight. Saturday work hours are 8am to 1pm.

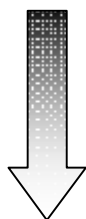

Noise impact

The RTA continues to examine and trial new ways to reduce construction noise. Last week a new method for excavating the median and pavement was trialed between Darling and Wellington streets. The type of pavement there enable it to be removed without using jack hammers. The work was able to be completed in less time resulting in less noise being created.

Noise impact will vary depending on your proximity to the noise source, protection by other structures and the type of building you reside in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's *Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan*, ranging on a scale of one to four. Go to www.innerwestbusway.com.au for further information:

Type 1 such as saw cutting and rock breaking – to be completed by midnight.

Type 2 such as excavation and loading trucks and compaction

Type 3 such as most hand tools, stockpiling, water carts and sweeping

Type 4 such as minor hand tools such as drilling, steel cutting and pavement painting vehicles
