

## Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION - Night work at White Bay

12 March, 2010

The RTA will investigate the location of services around the White Bay bus stop on Victoria Road as part of the design of the proposed cyclist and pedestrian improvements on the Inner West Busway.

The work will be done over four nights and will start on 16 March, 2010. This schedule is subject to weather, technical issues or innovations which may arise during this time.

#### Lane closure and access to footpath

The footpath and kerbside lane near the bus stop will be closed while these investigations take place. The bus stop will be temporarily relocated twenty metres towards the city. Cyclists and pedestrians will be guided through the site by traffic controllers. The traffic lane will be reopened daily when work is not in progress.

#### Noise

The service investigations will involve some potholing using a vacuum truck, a small excavator and handsaws. Noise levels will vary depending on how close you are to the noise source, protection by other structures and the type of building you live in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's *Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan*, ranging on a scale of one to four.
