

Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

IMPORTANT INFORMATION , ELECTRICAL SUBSTATION WORKS

Work is required to connect the permanent power supply to the Inner West Busway site from the electrical substation at the top end of Bymes Street. Work will include excavating a trench, connecting the power supply and backfilling the trench. This work will be done in conjunction with Energy Australia.

For this work to take place, three car spaces will be unavailable the top of Bymes Street for up to five days, from Tuesday 9 September to Saturday 12 September 2009.

Working hours

Working hours will be Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturday 7am to 4pm.

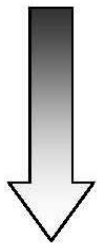
This schedule is subject to weather, technical issues or innovations which may arise during this time.

Traffic management will be in place to direct drivers safely around the work areas.

Noise impact

The work involves type two noisy works during the day.

Noise impact will vary depending on your proximity to the noise source, protection by other structures and the type of building you reside in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's *Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan* (CNVMP), ranging on a scale of one to four. - Type 1 such as saw cutting and rock breaking – **to be completed by midnight.**
- Type 2 such as excavation and loading trucks and compaction
- Type 3 such as most hand tools, stockpiling, water carts and sweeping
- Type 4 such as minor hand tools such as drilling, steel cutting and pavement painting vehicles
