

Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – Improvements to the cyclist and pedestrian path at the Rozelle end of Iron Cove Bridge

On Sunday 4 July, the RTA will widen the footpath at the top of the staircase next to Iron Cove Bridge in Rozelle to make it safer for pedestrians and cyclists.

The work will be carried out over five nights between 7pm to 6am (subject to weather conditions).

Works include:

- Use of an excavator to prepare the area for widening.
- Use of concrete trucks and other small plant to construct the new path.
- Laying new pavement markings, erecting signs and fencing.

The work needs to be done at night when traffic lanes can be closed safely. Temporary traffic lane closures and 40 km/h speed restrictions will be in place. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and cyclists.

The noisiest activities, such as concrete breaking, will be done before midnight. Other activities carried out between 12am and 6am are expected to produce some noise. The RTA will aim to minimise the effect on nearby residents.

Portable floodlights will be used during the work and the floodlights will be positioned to minimise any intrusive light entering nearby residential buildings.
