

Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - Toelle Street kerb adjustment

The RTA will start construction on the Toelle Street kerb adjustment from 4 September 2009 to early October 2009. The work will involve reconstructing the kerb at the intersection of Toelle Street and Victoria Road. All work will be carried out behind safety barriers which will be located between Callan Street and 30 metres west of Toelle Street. **This schedule is subject to weather, technical issues or innovations which may arise during this time.**

Working hours

Working hours will be Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and nights from 7pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.

The existing bus stop

The existing westbound bus stop, west of Toelle Street will be relocated about 25m to the west.

Traffic control

There will be safety barriers delineating the worksite from the traffic. Access to and from Toelle Street and Callan Street will be maintained at all times. Drivers are requested to take care and to follow the signs.

The mail zone

During construction the designated 'mail zone' parking space west of Toelle Street will be temporarily closed. Access to the post box will be maintained from the footpath.

Footpath access

A minimum of 1.5 metres will be maintained on the footpath for pedestrians at all times. Access to the Terry Street pedestrian crossing will be maintained at all times.

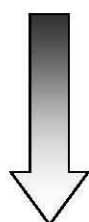
Lane closures

A temporary kerbside lane closure adjacent to the work area will be required for one day to install safety barriers around the worksite. The safety barrier will then remain in place until the new kerb alignment is complete.

The bus lane adjacent to the work area will be partially closed for the duration of the works, between Callan Street to 30 metres west of Toelle Street.

Noise impact

The work involves type one and two noisy work including saw cutting and hammering during the day. Noise impact will vary depending on your proximity to the noise source, protection by other structures and the type of building you live in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's *Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan*, ranging on a scale of one to four. Type 1 such as saw cutting and rock breaking – **to be completed by midnight.**

Type 2 such as excavation and loading trucks and compaction

Type 3 such as most hand tools, stockpiling, water carts and sweeping

Type 4 such as minor hand tools such as drilling, steel cutting and pavement painting vehicles
