Boating on Iron Cove What to expect on completion

A new bridge

The new bridge will be located on the western side of the existing Iron Cove Bridge and will carry three westbound traffic lanes. The existing Iron Cove Bridge will carry three citybound traffic lanes and a 24-hour bus lane.

2000 metre rowing course

Prior to work starting, rowing groups and NSW Maritime noted the need to align the bridge piers to minimise impacts to the rowing course under the bridges.

The RTA realigned the piers to meet this need.
