## King George Park What to expect during construction

### Summary

The RTA will temporarily lease a section of King George Park. This section will be used as a construction and work compound site. At this site, the RTA will:

- Construct and launch the new bridge.
- Accommodate the project team (offices, amenities, toilets, meal rooms and showers).
- Store equipment and materials necessary to build the project.
- Provide off street parking for staff to minimise impacts on local streets.

### Impact

This section of King George Park will be closed. Signs will be in place to direct cyclists and pedestrians safely around the site and to alternative routes to the Bay Run.

Some trees will be removed and the memorial relocated. A temporary replacement children's playground will be built close-by. The heritage abutments of the original Iron Cove Bridge will be protected from construction activity.

### Road closures

Local roads will remain open. The majority of trucks will access the construction area from Victoria Road. Some special deliveries may access the site from other local streets. Staff cars will use the local streets to then access the staff parking area in the work compound.

Temporary lane closures may be required on Victoria Road and other roads. Traffic management will be in place to direct drivers safely through or around the sites.

### Noise management

A temporary plywood hoarding will be built behind the tree line along the Byrnes Street boundary of the construction and compound site. This will help reduce noise from the site.

### Timeframe

The King George Park construction and work compound site will be set up in May 2009. After the removal of the compound the park will be restored.

Notifications will be delivered in the local area when work is due to start.

*Timeframes are estimates only. Times may change due to a number of factors, such as weather.*

### Construction hours

Due to the need to ensure that Victoria Road remains unimpeded during peak hours, the RTA has approval to undertake construction work at any time (24 hours per day). All construction activities done before 7am or after 6pm on any day, on weekends or public holidays, are subject to measures specified in the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan.
