The new bridge over Iron Cove What to expect on completion

A new bridge

The new bridge will be located on the western side of the existing Iron Cove Bridge and will carry three westbound traffic lanes. The existing Iron Cove Bridge will carry three citybound traffic lanes and a 24-hour bus lane. The clip-on lane on the existing Iron Cove Bridge will be closed and may be used to assist maintenance in the future.

Peak bus lane

An AM peak bus lane will operate westbound over the new bridge. This will give priority to buses, and improve travel times and reliability of bus services along Victoria Road.

Cyclist and pedestrian path

A 4.3 metre wide shared use cyclist and pedestrian path will be provided on the western side of the new bridge. This will have connections to the Bay Run and Victoria Road. This new path is in addition to the path on the existing Iron Cove Bridge.
