Driving through Rozelle What to expect during construction

Summary

Multiple crews will work along Victoria Road to:

- Remove the median and replace with a new redirective barrier.
- Adjust traffic signals and relocate utility services.
- Remove the right turn lanes into Gordon and Evans Streets.
- Remark traffic and bus lanes.
- Install overhead lane usage signs.
- Build the approaches to the new bridge.
- Remove palm trees between Evans and Darling Streets.
- Extend the right turn lanes (from both directions) into Darling Street.
- Install new pedestrian fencing.

Road closure

Victoria Road will remain open at all times. Temporary lane closures will be required. Traffic management will be in place to direct drivers safely through or around the sites.

Timeframe

Work is due to start in mid 2009 and take about 12 months to finish.

Detailed notifications will be delivered in the local area when work is about to start.

Timeframes are estimates only. Times may change due to a number of factors, such as weather.

Construction hours

Due to the need to ensure that Victoria Road remains unimpeded during peak hours, the RTA has approval to undertake construction work at any time (24 hours per day). All construction activities done before 7am or after 6pm on any day, on weekends or public holidays, are subject to measures specified in the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan.
