Driving through Drummoyne What to expect during construction

Summary

Multiple crews will work along Victoria Road to:

- Remove the median and rebuild the pavement.
- Adjust traffic signals and relocate utility services.
- Build the approaches to the new bridge.
- Remark traffic and bus lanes.
- Install the permanent 'quick moveable barrier'.
- Remove the slip lane at Lyons Road.
- Widen the footpath and remove the pedestrian island at the Lyons Road intersection.
- Adjust the left turn lane into Park Avenue.
- Establish a new bus bay at Cary Street.
- Install overhead lane usage signs.

Road closure

Victoria Road will remain open at all times. Temporary lane closures will be required. Traffic management will be in place to direct drivers safely through or around the work areas.

The Iron Cove Bridge clip-on lane may be closed during December and January in 2009/10 and 2010/11. It may also be closed on some weekends and evenings.

Timeframe

Work is due to start in early 2010 and take about nine months to finish.

The moveable median barrier will not start operation until the bridge is finished.

Notifications will be delivered in the local area when work is about to start.

Timeframes are estimates only. Times may change due to a number of factors, such as weather.

Construction hours

Due to the need to ensure that Victoria Road remains unimpeded during peak hours, the RTA has approval to undertake construction work at any time (24 hours per day). All construction activities done before 7am or after 6pm on any day, on weekends or public holidays, are subject to measures specified in the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan.
