

Inner West Busway along Victoria Road

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – Resurfacing on Victoria Road between Terry Street and The Crescent

As part of the work to build the new busway between The Crescent and Terry Street on Victoria Road, this section of Victoria Road will next be resurfaced. Large sections of the road will be closed to remove and replace the existing road surface and to apply new pavement markings.

Work will start on the citybound lanes at Terry Street and progress towards The Crescent. Work on the westbound lanes will start at The Crescent and progress towards Terry Street.

Noise

The work will be done at night when large sections of the road can be safely closed. It will involve short periods of high noise activity such as jackhammering and machines that need reversing beeps throughout the night. Most residents should only be exposed to this noise for 2 nights in total.

Residents next to the major intersections on Victoria Road will have adjacent work for at least two nights in a row. The work needs to be completed in stages so that Victoria Road can be opened in a safe condition for traffic each morning.

Lane closures and traffic detours

Lanes will be closed and traffic detoured during this resurfacing.

Police patrols, traffic controllers and signage will direct vehicles safely through the work area. A 40km/h speed zone is necessary for driver and worker safety. Drivers are requested to take care and follow the signs and the directions of traffic controllers.

Important information about access

Because new asphalt needs to be compacted and cooled down, some access will not be possible. Access to properties on Victoria Road and side streets in the work zone will be restricted between 10pm and 5am and detours will be in place. Residents and business owners will be contacted individually to discuss these arrangements.

Bus stops may be temporarily relocated (if required). Traffic controllers will assist bus passengers.

Program

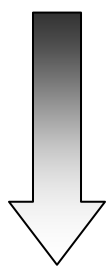

Important information about noise during construction for residents

The impact of noise will vary depending on your proximity to the noise source, protection provided by other structures and the type of building you reside in. Noise levels have been identified in the project's *Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan*, ranging on a scale of one to four. Noisy

Type 1 such as saw cutting and jackhammering – **to be completed by midnight.**

Type 2 such as excavation and loading trucks and milling

Type 3 such as most hand tools and sweeping

Type 4 such as minor hand tools such as drilling, rolling and pavement painting vehicles

Less Noisy

Intermittent periods of high noise levels between 12am and 5am will be unavoidable and may be experienced by residents in the immediate vicinity of the work. **If you experience extended periods of medium to high levels of noisy work and are concerned, please contact the community relations team on 1300 780 841.**
